

Dancing Curtain seeks Pepsi aid to ‘spring the Laughter’ to many

The Dancing Curtain LLC, a comedy business based in Ridgefield, CT, is in the running for a Pepsi Refresh Grant.

Pepsi is giving away thousands of dollars to the public in the form of Pepsi Refresh grants. Individuals, not-for-profit organizations, and for profit businesses are welcome to apply for grants from \$5,000 to \$50,000. Every month from May through the end of the year the public is encouraged to vote for their favorite idea to refresh the community. Each cycle Pepsi accepts an unlimited number of applicants but selects only 1,500 ideas to go into the running each cycle.

The Dancing Curtain’s idea is to spread laughter to thousands of people in California through a month of free comedic plays. This idea would allow at least 2,000 to 4,000 people to see free live theater, a comedic one woman show.

“California has the highest unemployment rate of any state in the U.S. and is near bankruptcy. The grant would give Californians a needed boost,” said Khristee Rich, President of The Dancing Curtain, who is currently writing the show and will also perform in the production. If the show earns positive reviews, it will go on tour.
